

# French egg production in decrease from end of summer 2004

- 15, 5 billion eggs produced in 2004 (+2,8%/2003)
- 48 millions laying hens included 8,3 millions hens in alternative systems:
  - ✓ 4,4 million in free range (standard)
  - ✓ 1,3 million in free range (label rouge)
  - ✓ 1,3 million in organic farms
  - ✓ 1,4 million in barn systems





# EVOLUTION OF EGG PRODUCTS PRODUCTION IN FRANCE

- Egg product production = nearly 300 000 Tons in shell egg equivalent
- 30 % of French egg production
- still a growing sector (+ 3,7 % in 2004/2003)


# EGG PRODUCT CONSUMPTION STILL INCREASING

- Global egg consumption : 253 eggs / pers/year
- part of egg product consumption still increasing :  
30 % of total consumption  
expected : 36 % of total consumption in 2012
- Self sufficiency globally stable
- Beginning of 2005 : imports↗ and  
↘commercial surplus in egg product
